


Downloading ArcGIS Pro

This document contains step-by-step instructions on how to download ArcGIS Pro to your computer or laptop. ArcGIS Pro is a powerful desktop mapping application that has advanced mapping capabilities compared to ArcGIS Online.

Part One: Setting your members up as 'GIS Professional Advance' and 'Publisher'

1. Login to arcgis.com
2. Click on **Organisation** and navigate to the **Members** tab. This is a place where you can invite and manage users.

Make all users **GIS Professional Advanced**. This enables users to download ArcGIS Pro.

Change privileges of each user by clicking the drop-down arrow. Teachers should be **Administrators** and students should be **Publishers**.


3. Ensure that any member that needs to access and download ArcGIS Pro is set as the following:

- **User Type:** GIS Professional Advanced
- **Role:** Publisher

Note: if you need to still [add your students](#), you can ensure they are automatically set up as the correct User Type and Role by specifying this. An example of this is below:



4. Once you – or other members – are set up as ‘GIS Professional Advanced’ (User Type) and ‘Publisher’ (Role) you will be able to download ArcGIS Pro.
5. In ArcGIS Online, click on your username in the top-right corner of the screen. Then click on ‘My Settings’.
