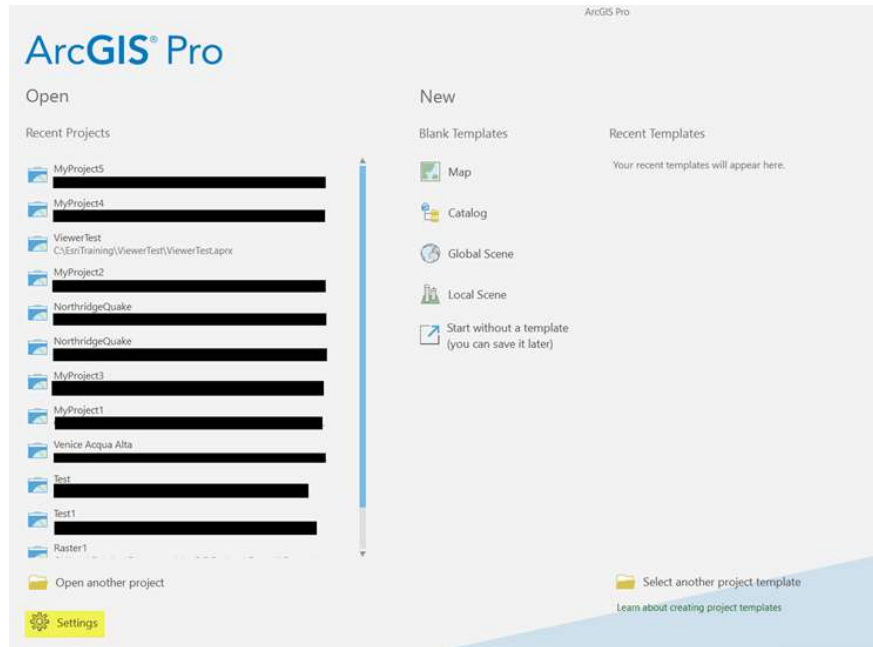


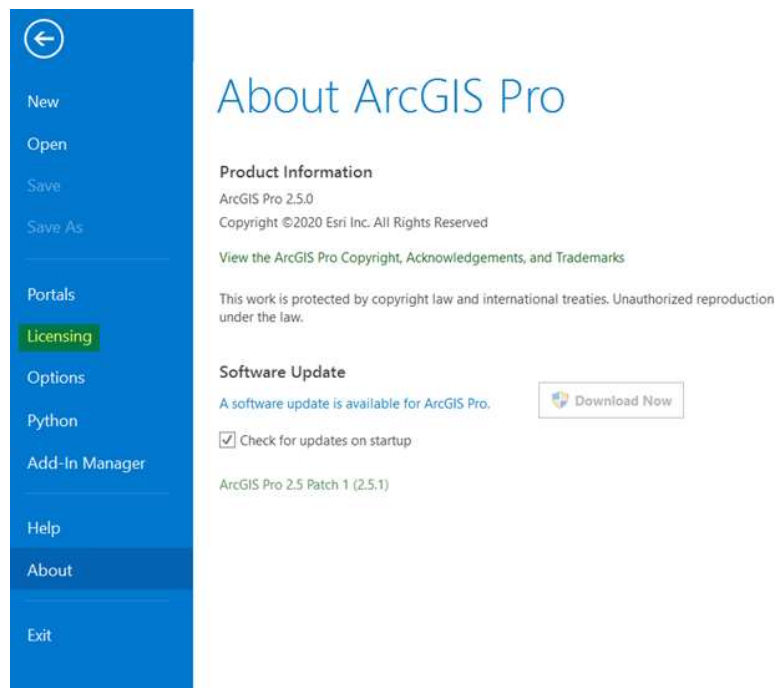


De-authorise ArcGIS Pro Single Use Use Licenses Offline

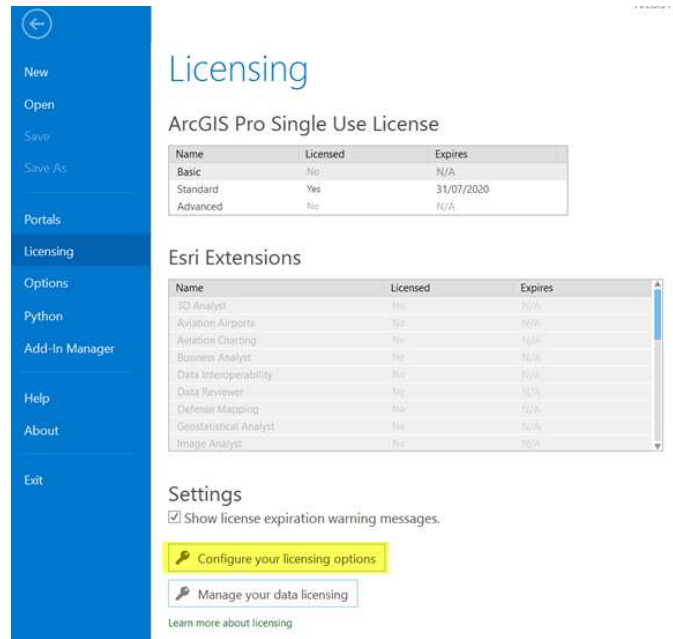
Open your ArcGIS Pro and choose the "Settings" button at the bottom of the page.



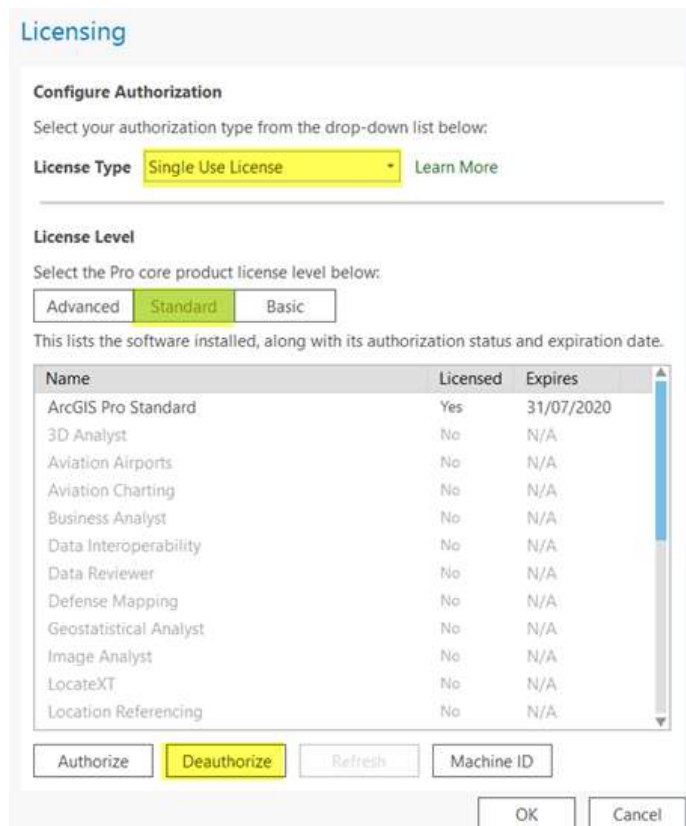
Select the option "Licensing" from the panel outlined below.



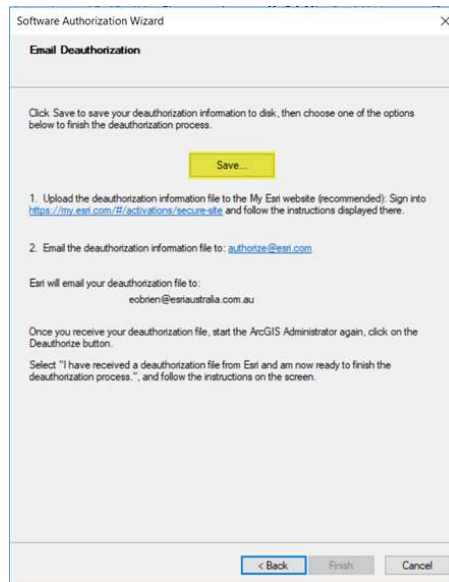
Select the "Configure your licensing options" button.



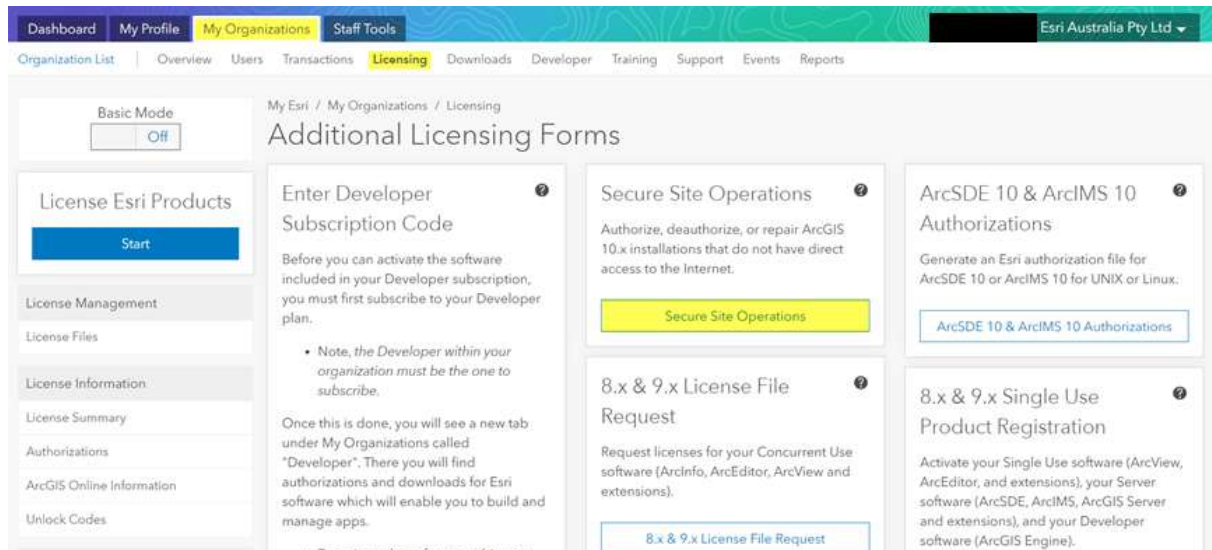
Check that "Single Use" is selected in the drop-down menu, as well as the license level you wish to remove. Click the "De-authorize" button.



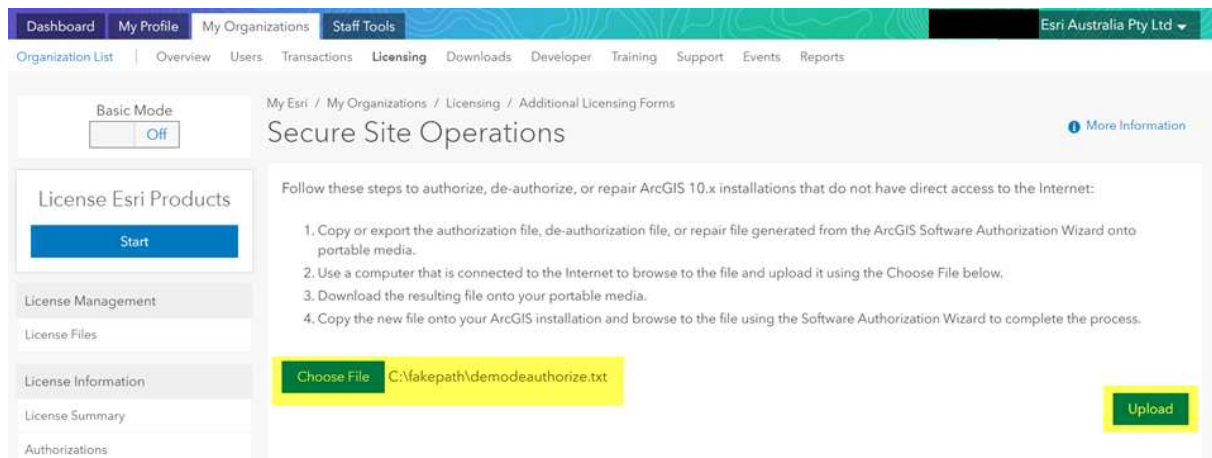
Click the "Save" button to produce a de-authorize.txt file and save to a location that you can easily browse to.



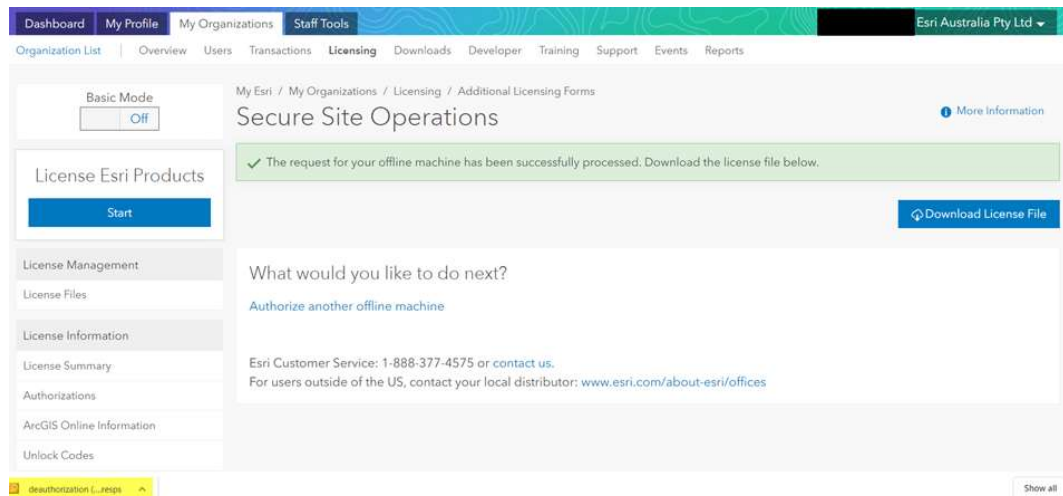
From an internet connected machine, log into My Esri (the account must have a minimum permission to take licensing actions). Navigate to My Organisation > Additional Licensing Forms > Secure Site Operations.



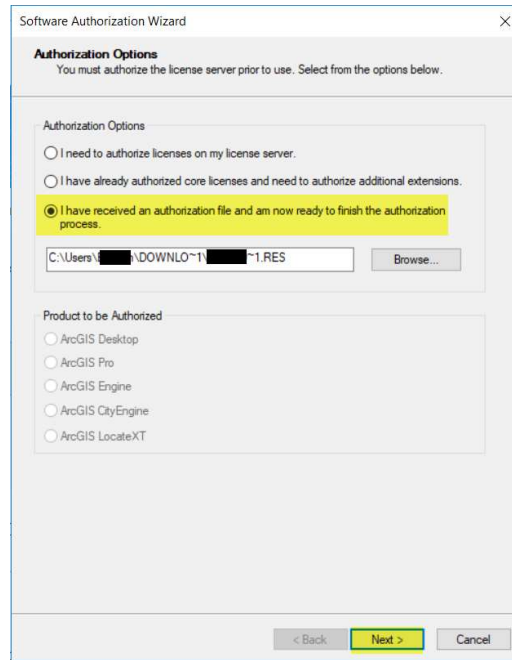
Using the "Choose File" button, browse to the de-authorize.txt that you created earlier and choose the "Upload" button.



Your secure de-authorisation file will download and will display at the bottom left hand side of your web browser. Click the file and allow to run and make changes to your machine where prompted.



You will be launched back into the software de-authorisation and your file automatically referenced. Click the "Next" button to proceed.



You will receive notification that the authorisation as completed and will list the features authorised. Click the "Finish" button.
